
# STACK LOGS NEAT AND CLEAN

## **Log Holder**

This sturdy log holder makes stacking easier and keeps your firewood organized and off the ground. Use 2x4 preservative-treated lumber with Simpson Strong-Tie<sup>®</sup> Rigid Tie<sup>®</sup> RTC2Z connectors to build this log holder any size you need in less than an hour.



#### **TOOLS YOU NEED**

- Saw
- Screw gun
- 1/4" hex head socket
- Tape measure
- Clamps
- Glamps
- Framing square

### RIGID TIE® RTC2Z CONNECTOR INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

#### 1. CUT LUMBER TO SIZE.

Since all of your cuts are straight cuts, Simpson Strong-Tie<sup>®</sup> connectors simplify building with wood.

## 2. INSTALL CONNECTOR ON VERTICAL POST.

Mark height, clamp connector to post and attach with #9x1½"

Strong-Drive<sup>®</sup> SD Connector screws.



#### 3. CONNECT Horizontal Rail On Each Side.

Use a clamp to help hold the wood in the seat of the connector during installation.


